

What to Bring to Summer Camp:

Everything they bring should pack into one of the extra-large zipper type duffle bags or two medium size bags. Their gear must be kept neat and stored under their bunk each day.

Put your name on EVERYTHING

- Scout Uniform - at least 1 Class A and Class B's (Plain Navy Blue T-shirt in place of class A shirt)
- Plenty of Scout Socks
- Scout Shorts
- Navy Blue T-shirts
- Underwear
- Closed Toe Shoes/ Boots
- Cap/Hat
- Something to sleep in (gym shorts, etc)
- Sleeping Bag or Bed Roll
- Pillow
- Poncho or Raingear
- Jacket for cool nights (it can get cold)
- Towels for swimming and showers
- Washcloth
- Soap/ Shampoo (in travel case)
- Shower shoes
- Toothpaste/Toothbrush
- Comb, mirror
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Pocket Knife/ Totin' Chip
- Insect Repellent
- Swim Trunks
- Sunscreen
- Boy Scout Handbook (a must)
- Notebook/ pens/ pencils
- Merit badge books and completed prerequisites
- Bible/ prayer book
- Work Gloves
- Personal First Aid Kit
- Dirty Clothes Bag
- Backpack or duffle bag (may have to carry gear to campsite)
- Spending Money (Some merit badges have additional fees, see page two for fees and what they can purchase at the trading post)

OLD Throw-away Shoes and Clothes for Adventure Valley these will be ruined and thrown away. They may save the shoes for (may save shoes for below)

Old clothes for items for test below (no holes in clothes and baggy clothes are best for taking off wet):

For swimming merit badge scouts must: Demonstrate survival skills by leaping into deep water wearing clothes (**shoes, socks, swim trunks, long pants, belt, and long-sleeved shirt**). Remove shoes and socks, remove and inflate the shirt, and show that you can float using the shirt for support. Remove and inflate the pants for support. Swim 50 feet using the inflated pants for support, then show how to re-inflate the pants while using them for support.
